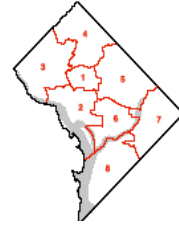

Overview:

Participants will learn how to make necessary repairs to a toilet tank.

Objectives:

- * How to replace ballcock assembly
- * How to replace tank ball or flapper
- * How adjust water level
- * How to replace handle
- * What tools are needed?

Potential Outcomes:

- * Participant will be able to replace all defective parts of a toilet tank
- * Participant will save money on their water bill

Impact:

- * Participant can save approximately \$ 95.00 per self-repair
